Data Breaches and Disclosures

A **USB drive containing personally identifiable information was stolen** from a University of Vermont employee. An undisclosed number of individuals had their **names, aliases, addresses, social security numbers, dates of birth, driver's license numbers** and more compromised.

A database containing **names and social security numbers** of the University of Wisconsin-Madison Law School applicants was hacked. Over **1,200 individuals were affected**.

Student's **personal information was accidentally placed on a public section** of San Jose Evergreen Community College District's website. An undisclosed number of students were affected.
